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
WHAT ABSORBS

WHAT TO DO:

- 1. GO ON A HUNT AROUND THE BACKYARD AND COLLECT VARIOUS OBJECTS FROM NATURE. SORT AND PLACE IN A MUFFIN TIN.
- 2. POUR WATER OVER YOUR NATURE COLLECTIONS IN EACH SECTION IN THE MUFFIN TIN.
- 3. MAKE A GUESS IF EACH OBJECT WILL ABSORB THE WATER OR NOT.

- MUFFIN TIN
- NATURE
- WATER



WHAT NOT TO DO:

NATURE OBJECTS THAT WORK GREAT FOR THIS: ROCKS, LEAVES, GRASS, PINE CONES, DANDELIONS, FLOWERS, ETC.
